1. ACCOMPLISHED BETWEEN NOVEMBER 2015 – NOVEMBER 2016

- Held a joint committee meeting of the Security Committee and the Terminal & Facilities Committee on March 1 at the 2016 ACC/AAAE Airport Planning, Design and Construction Symposium in Salt Lake City. Michael Duffy from TSA was the special guest speaker
- Moderated the TSA Update Panel with Paul Beruman, Mike Duffy and the local SLC DFSD. The session was attended by over 100 participants
- Hosted the ACC/TSA Security Capabilities Day (SCD) Workshop, July 19-21, with a record 230+ participants including 50 from TSA. Many view this as the best industry security event available
- Michael Saunders, Security Committee Vice Chair presented the work of the Security Committee on Cyber Security at the Airport Planning, Design and Construction Symposium
- Held a Security Committee Conference Call on April 22, to update members and kick-off committee planning for the ACC/TSA Security Capabilities Workshop, July 19-21
- Held a Cyber Security Webinar developed by the Committee. This effort was led by committee vice chair Michael Saunders.
- Discussed options relating to other security-related webinars that can be held by ACC, including the updated checkpoint and checked baggage design guidelines
- Provided industry updates on the efforts of ASAC, PARAS, ARCP, PGDS and RTCA to committee members
- Held Security Committee in person meeting on July 20
- Held Security Committee teleconference on September 22
- Continued to offer comments to TSA on issues of interest for committee members
- Prepared for the CyberSecurity webinar sponsored by the Security Committee
- Continued to grow the Security Committee and keep members updated on industry trends and opportunities. The Security Committee has grown to 65 ACC participants

2. RECOMMENDED ACTIVITIES FOR 2016/2017

ACC Security Committee members will continue to participate in working groups consisting of industry representatives and TSA staff and report back to the Security Committee, particularly gathering comments on the Checkpoint Design Guidelines (CDG) and the Planning Guidelines and Design Standards (PGDS); 2) the committee will work with the TSA as they develop future acquisitions plans and the procedures associated with them; improving the test & evaluation process for qualifying security

screening equipment; 3) participate with the TSA as they consider developing strategies to bring third party testing and open architecture to bring technologies to market; 4) Continue the Security Committee's effort to educate members on the growing importance of Cyber Security, insuring that ACC members will be aware of the most current strategies; and work with the TSA as they formulate plans to bring innovative measures to US airport passenger screening checkpoints.
