HOW IT WORKS:

Delegates can register for either Horizontal or Vertical (or both) sessions. Depending on the number of participants, we may only be able to accommodate your top choice. Once the registration period has closed, the data will be reviewed and a confirmation will be sent out to all registrants with their appointment schedules. Each appointment/session will be 5 minutes in length. Total appointments available will depend on number of participants and hosts.

Registration will include a link to a short survey to collect some info:

- Contact information
- Choose either “horizontal” or “vertical” session (there will be an option to choose both, however we won’t be able to guarantee both)
- Name minimum 5 people or firms you would like to meet with
