- **Personal Electronic Devices (PEDS) Ban Issues:**
 - In order to respond more effectively to the rapidly changing threat environment, the EU and the US must leverage existing security information-sharing networks to ensure all stakeholders have the necessary information to develop solutions.
- **Recommendations:**
 - The EU Commission (DG MOVE) and TSA are requested to engage in consultations with industry at an early stage as States develop strategies to deal with critical threats.
 - Harmonised EDS CB detection standards and communicate these to aviation security technology developers at the earliest opportunity.
 - ACI EUROPE airports, airline associations and aviation security technology developers and TSA to share operational trials data.
 - The TSA is requested to share experience and best practice on alarm resolution.
 - The EU and the TSA are invited to engage with stakeholders on possible alterations to regulation that will enable the adoption of EDSCB.
 - The EU and TSA are encouraged to explore mutually agreeable testing methodologies for screening and detection technologies.
 - The EU and USA should investigate the introduction of standardisation requirements for security equipment.
