Robert Poole is the director of transportation policy and co-founder of the Reason Foundation. He is an MIT-trained engineer, and has advised the Ronald Reagan, the George H.W. Bush, the Bill Clinton, and the George W. Bush administrations. Poole will discuss the modest resurgence of interest in U.S. airport privatization and public-private partnerships since the first Midway Airport privatization effort. He will contrast the U.S. situation with the continued global trend of airport privatization and will speculate on how airports may fit into the Trump Administration's private-capital-oriented infrastructure agenda.

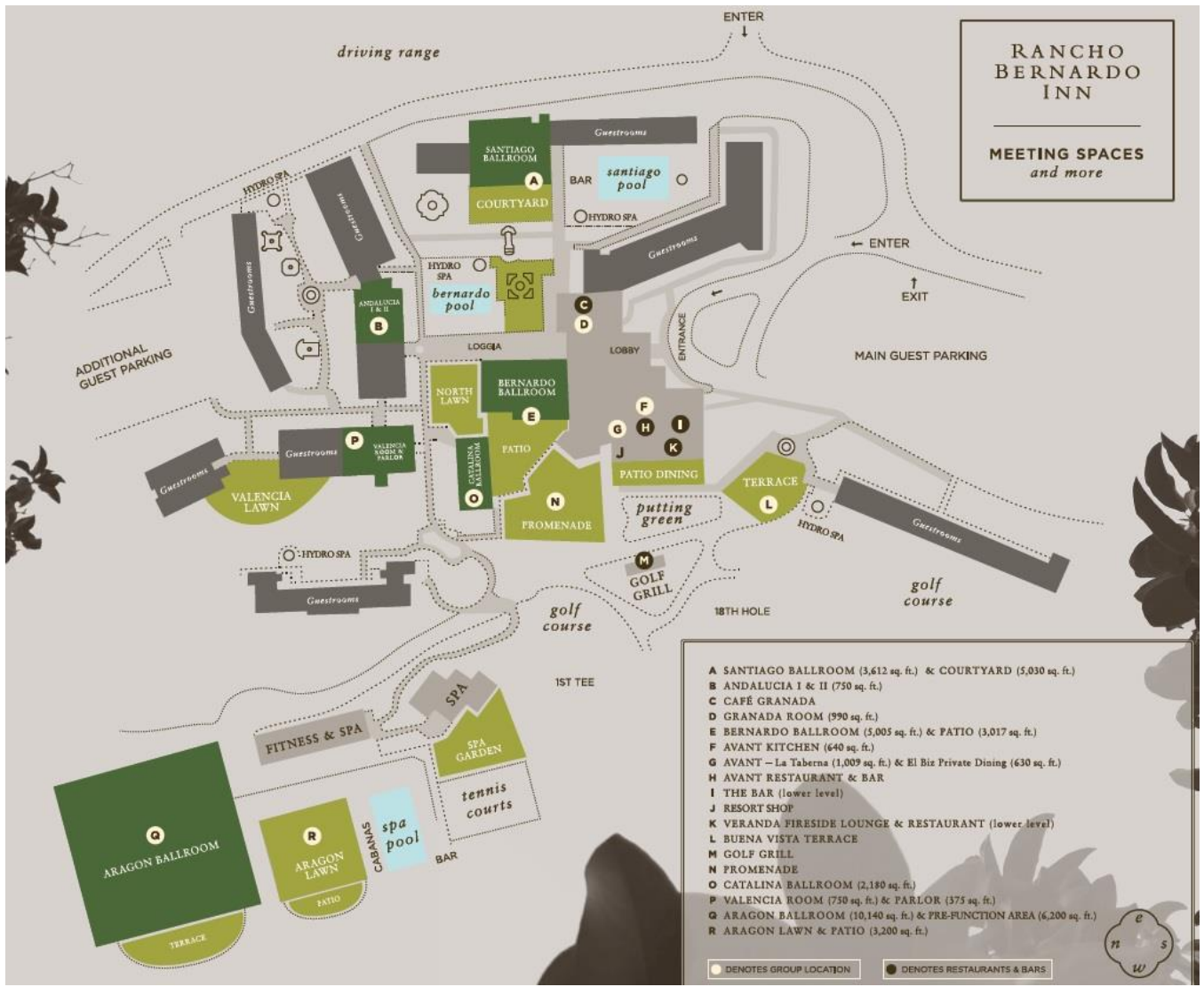
